English III Academic

Course Description

English III is a chronological survey of American literature from the early sixteenth century to the present. Through a study of fiction, non-fiction, poetry, and prose, students analyze literature using several critical lenses to produce written responses that demonstrate a high level of comprehension and knowledge of how American literature reflects the American experience. There is a strong emphasis on research writing and analyzing argumentative/persuasive devices in non-fiction texts. Assessment includes writing, online discussions, vocabulary drills, grammar exercises, and projects. After successfully completing English III, students take English IV.
