Credit Recovery English I

The purpose of this course is to allow students who have previously failed English I to gain mastery of course concepts. English I students study all genres of literature and explore the ways audience, purpose, and context shape oral communication, written communication, media, and technology. While emphasis is placed on communicating for purposes of personal expression, students also engage in meaningful communication for expressive, expository, argumentative, and literary purposes. There is a strong concentration on grammar, vocabulary development, writing, and reading comprehension with increasingly complex texts. Students will pre-assess at the beginning of each unit to determine their course work path.
