



Credit Recovery English III

The purpose of this course is to allow students who have previously failed English III to gain mastery of course concepts. English III is a chronological survey of American literature from the early sixteenth century to the present. Through a study of fiction, non-fiction, poetry, and prose, students analyze literature using several critical lenses to produce written responses that demonstrate a high level of comprehension and knowledge of how American literature reflects the American experience. There is a strong emphasis on research writing and analyzing argumentative/persuasive devices in non-fiction texts. Assessment includes writing, online discussions, vocabulary drills, grammar exercises, and projects. Students will pre-assess at the beginning of each unit to determine their course work path.
