



Credit Recovery English IV

The purpose of this course is to allow students who have previously failed English IV to gain mastery of course concepts that integrate all the language arts skills gained throughout students' education. Students enrolled in English IV continue to explore expressive, expository, argumentative, and literary texts with a focus on British literature, including how the literature of Great Britain has influenced the literature of the United States. English IV students also study the connections of themes, ideas, and movements in British literature. Emphasis is on argumentation by developing a position of advocacy through reading, writing, speaking, listening, and using media. There is a strong concentration on grammar, vocabulary development, and increased reading comprehension. Students will pre-assess at the beginning of each unit to determine their course work path.
