Credit Recovery Algebra I

The purpose of this course is to allow students who have previously failed Algebra I to gain mastery of course concepts in working with and evaluating mathematical expressions, equations, graphs, and other topics. Students will be introduced to operations with real numbers and polynomials, relations and functions, creation and application of linear functions and relations. The course will also introduce nonlinear functions. Assessments within the course include multiple-choice, short-answer, or extended response questions. Also included in this course are self-check quizzes, audio tutorials, and interactive games. Students will pre-assess at the beginning of each unit to determine their course work path.
