



Credit Recovery U.S. History

The purpose of this course is to allow students who have previously failed US History to gain mastery of course concepts. United States History is designed as a survey course and a continuation of the Civics and Economics curriculum. The curriculum begins with the Washington administration and continues to current times. This course provides students with a framework for studying political, social, economic, and cultural issues, and for analyzing the impact these issues have had on American society. This course goes beyond memorization of isolated facts to the development of higher level thinking skills, encouraging students to make historical assessments and evaluations. Students will pre-assess at the beginning of each unit to determine their course work path.
