



Credit Recovery World History

The purpose of this course is to allow students who have previously failed World History to gain mastery of course concepts; the course gives students the opportunity to explore recurring themes of human experience common to civilizations around the globe from ancient to contemporary times. Students will examine the historical roots of significant events, ideas, and movements. They will broaden their historical perspectives as they explore ways societies have dealt with continuity and change as exemplified by issues such as war and peace, internal stability and strife, and the development of institutions. This course serves as a foundation for Civics and Economics. Students will pre-assess at the beginning of each unit to determine their course work path.
