## NCVPS CREDIT RECOVERY

The NCVPS Credit Recovery program is unique in its design and implementation. This is no point and click model! Students are actively engaged in the learning as they work with a NC certified teacher through the course. Important points to remember:

1. Students must show mastery of all goals and objectives of the NC Standard Course of Study.
2. Students will work on various levels of the revised Bloom's Taxonomy as they learn concepts and demonstrate their learning.
3. A NC certified teachers work asynchronously with students daily and synchronously with students at least once a week.
4. Students will experience the learning through interacting with content, seeing content, viewing content, and reading content.

### Why is NCVPS the logical solution?

The NCVPS Credit Recovery program is the logical solution because it does more than meet an immediate learning need -- it provides for the long term learning for students; here they will learn skills and concepts that will translate to not only immediate success but increased long term success as a foundation for learning is provided. Students will be ready for the next level of instruction.
